UPS Building Additional 15 CNG Fueling Stations and Increasing CNG Fleet

Plans to deploy 1,400 CNG tractors and delivery vehicles





UPS announced plans to build 15 compressed natural gas (CNG) fueling stations to support the purchase and planned deployment of 1,400 new CNG vehicles over the next year. Twelve of the CNG stations will be in new natural gas vehicle deployment areas, and three will replace existing CNG stations with more robust, higher capacity equipment.
