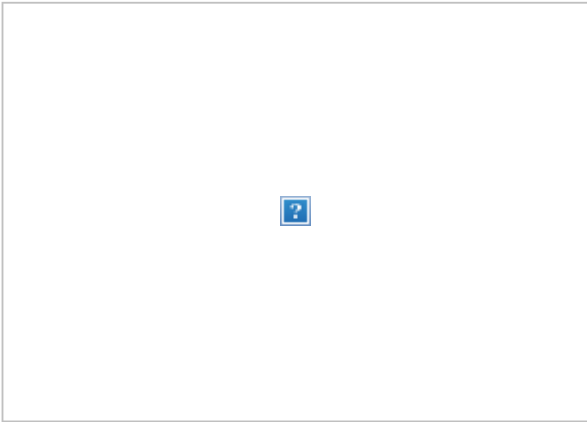
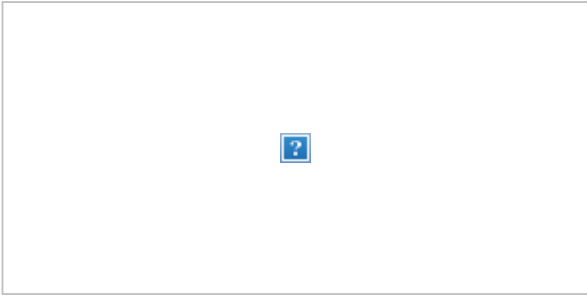


KCFC Takes Center Stage for CNG This Week
