





KCFC and Bob Hook Chevrolet Team to Educate about Electric Volt

(08.29.2012) Bob Hook Chevrolet, Louisville has made a 2012 Chevy Volt available to the KCFC for 5,000 miles. This 'moving classroom' will enable schools, the general public and fleets to see the vehicle and understand its efficiency as a plug-in electric vehicle with a gasoline engine as back up. 2,500 Volts were sold in August.



Funding Awarded for Hybrid School Buses

The Kentucky Department of Education announced today that two school districts in Kentucky will receive funding for the purchase of hybrid electric school buses. Bullitt County will receive \$311,945 for the purchase of five buses and Campbell County \$64,091 for one hybrid bus.


These six bring the total to 168 on order or in operation across the state.

Kentucky has the largest hybrid electric school bus fleet in the nation.



Compressed Natural Gas Fueling Permit Now Available in Kentucky

The State of Kentucky Fire Marshal's Office has created and made available--on their website and ours--the first [CNG Specific Fueling Permit](#) required for siting of CNG refueling across Kentucky.
