



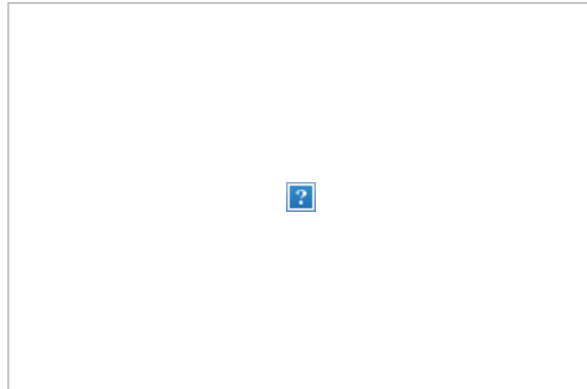

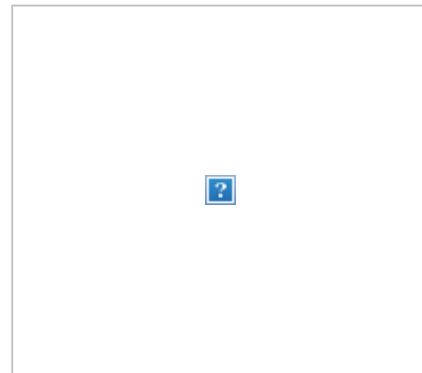

Kentucky Reaches Out to Natural Gas Vehicle Dealers

07.11.2012 - The National Association of State Procurement Officials (NASPO) and its fifty-six member states are drafting a Request for Proposal for the purchase of OEM natural gas vehicles. The lead state for this effort is Oklahoma. We anticipate that the solicitation will be released on **July 24 (we will post on the website as soon as it is available)**. Responses will be due to Oklahoma (as the lead state) in late August/early September.

This effort was begun in April with the release of an RFI (announced on this website) by Colorado. As of today, 20 states have indicated an Intent to Participate in this effort, including: Colorado, Connecticut, Hawaii, Kentucky, Louisiana, Maine, Minnesota, Mississippi, Montana, Nevada, New Mexico, Ohio, Oklahoma, Pennsylvania, South Carolina, Texas, Utah, Vermont, West Virginia and Wyoming.





If you are a dealer who does or can or wants to potentially provide OEM natural gas vehicles to any of these states we strongly encourage you to contact your OEM and get certified to provide warranty repair services for NGV's. We understand that this certification can take some time and potential responders will have to be certified in order to be able to submit compliant responses. We would encourage potential dealer responders to act NOW.
