



KCFC Members Awarded Funding for Natural Gas Projects

Governor Steve Beshear and Kentucky Transportation Cabinet (KYTC) officials today announced the award of \$2,501,591 in Congestion Mitigation and Air Quality (CMAQ) funds to LexTran, more than \$1.2 million in funds were awarded to the Lexington-Fayette Urban County Government to improve safety and air quality in Kentucky's second-largest city, and more than \$3 million for three projects in Jefferson County to improve safety and air quality in one of the busiest areas of the Commonwealth.
