Funding Opportunity from EPA

EPA's National Clean Diesel Campaign (NCDC) will begin accepting applications for a new rebate program on November 13, 2012. An important change in the Diesel Emissions Reduction Act (DERA) reauthorization was to allow EPA to award rebates. This first year of rebates will be a pilot program focusing on the replacement of older school buses in both public and private fleets. The total funding for this opportunity will be approximately \$2 million. Chrysler Begins Production of Ram 2500 CNG Pickup Truck



Chrysler announced Oct. 30 that the first Ram 2500 compressed natural gas (CNG) pickup trucks began coming off the assembly line at the company's Saltillo, Mexico, assembly plant.

The Ram 2500 CNG is a bi-fuel pickup truck that uses natural gas as its primary fuel. The truck will automatically switch to gasoline when the CNG tanks are empty. Chrysler stated that the Ram CNG will transition to gasoline with little difference in operation or capabilities when it does so.
