## **New Green Vehicles to Debut at 2012 LA Auto Show**

*The 2012 LA Auto Show will open Nov. 30-Dec. 9 for the public.*

Two dozen all-electric and plug-in electric models, more than a dozen clean-diesel vehicles, and nearly 20 vehicles achieving 40-plus mpg will be featured at the Los Angeles Auto Show!!

So far, the LA Auto Show has announced the following vehicles will be on display:

- Electric: Fiat 500e; Ford C-MAX Energi plug-in hybrid, Fusion Energi plug-in, and Focus Electric; and Honda Accord plug-in.
- Diesel: 2013 Volkswagen Beetle Cabriolet and Mercedes-Benz GLK250 BlueTEC.
- Gasoline: Dodge Dart Aero, Fiat 500 Abarth Cabriolet, and Mini Paceman

## **Westport Lowers Price of CNG Bi-fuel Conversion System**

Westport Innovations Inc. is lowering the price of its CNG Bi-fuel conversion system (WiNG Power System) to help make natural gas vehicles more affordable and accessible for U.S. truck fleets. The price is going from \$9,750 to \$9,500 starting with the 2013 Ford F-250 and F-350 Super Duty pickup truck models.

The Westport WiNG System is designed to travel 300 miles on CNG alone, and 650 miles with both tanks full. Fleets are expected to save up to \$2 or more per gallon in fuel costs and demonstrate positive payback in approximately two years.
