

As a registered training site and exam provider, the students of Grant County will have to opportunity to graduate high school with the certification required for entry-level PV technicians positions. Tom Pitts will teach the new set of courses for the Grant County High School students. The school also plans to hold evening classes for adults who would like to acquire the certificate.

"We see this as a great opportunity for our students to be better prepared for the job market right after graduation," Pitts said.
